Marking methods that may be used to complete your top are the purple air erasable marker, blue marker or chalk products such as Miracle Chalk or chalk sticks. These methods are removed by air/time, spritzing, steam and/or washing. Spray starch, Spray sizing and Spray baste, are product that sometimes are used in the aid of quilting your top, which require washing once the quilt is bound and finished. I have never had a problem with any of these methods but have heard of problems.

I have never had a problem with the blue water soluble markers and I use them on my own quilts. But, I have also heard of problems and I want you to be aware of potential problems. I do not use the blue markers unless I have no other choice and most of the time, on heirloom and custom quilts, using the blue markers is necessary.

1. I represent that the fabrics in this quilt have been washed and I am confident that the colors will not run when spritzed with water to remove the marks.
2. I understand that on occasions there have been problems with removal of marks made by markers and I am willing to take this risk.
3. I understand that Nadia Wilson will do her best to remove certain marks/chalk by spritzing with water and/or steam after the quilting is completed.
4. I have been advised by Nadia Wilson that once the quilt is bound and finished (as soon as possible), the quilt should be soaked/immersed/rinsed in cold water to be sure the blue marks or products are gone.
5. I understand that if I do not soak/immerse the quilt in cold water, the chance is greater that the marks may re-appear at a later date, especially if blue marker was used.
6. Nadia Wilson has explained to me that heat will set the blue marks even though I may not see them. Ironing or leaving the quilt in heat or direct sunlight may cause any residual blue ink to become permanent.
7. I agree to hold Nadia Wilson harmless and make no claims against her for any problems involving the use of the blue markers or any other type of product/marketing method on my quilts.
